  - Director of Youth & Family Ministry/Congregational Life Coordinator Update
    - We have had a great pool of candidates with a variety of gifts to offer. Two candidates are returning for second interviews. Positive thoughts about the candidates have been received from the hiring committee.
  - Congregation Council Nominating Committee Update
    - Three positions are open. Bonnie Hyda is chair of the committee. The committee has begun calling and asking for commitments.
  - Invite + Grow + Serve Subgroup Reports
    - A progress report was presented from the "Serve" subgroup. Warling shared about the Google Forums spreadsheet created to assist in gathering and holding

information, sorting, and organizing our efforts to pair volunteers with service opportunities. The tool could be rolled out in January.

- A progress report was presented from the "Invite" subgroup. Ratekin shared notes from meetings with the Windsor Heights Fire Chief and other city leaders. The group will synthesize information from meeting and present community service opportunities to discuss for next steps.
- A progress report was presented from the "Grow" subgroup. Franklin discussed their surveys and having them finalized in the next few weeks.

    - Inez Boyken has volunteered to spearhead the council-hosted potluck for the Annual meeting on January 21. She will recruit helpers from council members.
