

## August Council Meeting Report to Congregation

Your Congregational Council met the last week of August and wants to provide you the following updates discussed.

- 2019 marks WHLC's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and we'd like to celebrate this event! A celebration task force is being formed to provide ideas and recommendations on how we'd like to observe the occasion. If you are interested in participating on this team, please let a pastor or council member know.
- Also for 2019, the Congregation's Annual Meeting date has been set for Sunday, January 27<sup>th</sup> at 1 PM. More information will be communicated as this date approaches.
- As part of our ongoing review of security, Council approved a proposal from Strauss to install a security system that will include video monitoring at the main entrance and a buzz door entry system for office staff during the day when activities are not occurring at the facility. This is one of several recommendations that were brought forward by the security task force.
- Updated proposals were reviewed for an enhanced permanent sign. Options being considered will be discussed in upcoming E-Weekly's and the Window. Be on the lookout for this information.
- Finally, a generous gift was received towards installing acoustical paneling in Parish Hall along with an assisted listening system to incorporate with the existing sound system. Council approved the project along with the contractor proposal. A small team from the congregation will review further design and installation considerations. This will be a great improvement to an area widely used by our congregation and a number of outside groups and organizations.
