

The WHLC Congregation Council met on April 23.

- The April 23 meeting began with as a WHLC Foundation Meeting; Marc Fasse, the Foundation treasurer made a report; The foundation assets total \$500,000+; Marc reported that \$19,800 is to be distributed to various charities; of that, \$2,400 is available for WHLC projects. The Council elected Jill Hyda as Kevin Nicolet's successor to the Foundation Board.
- Zach Meyer reported on staff discussions about the youth programs at WHLC; the Parish Ed. Committee is considering a programming shift from Sunday School to Wednesday evening faith formation; Zach welcomes any thoughts that you may have on the subject.
- Duane Danielson, WHLC Treasurer, reported that General Offering year to date receipts are 95.2% of revenue needed to satisfy the year to date budgeted expenditures.
- The WHLC pictorial directory is almost complete and will be available soon on the church website. Council decided that the directory should be password protected. More information coming soon.
- We approved 12 week leave of absence for our office manager Heidi, who is expecting a baby in July; Linda Fasse will fill the position during Heidi's leave..
- Council discussed the Worship Times Survey data and input from the recent Adult Forum. The Executive Committee will consider a process for gathering additional input from congregation members in coming weeks, with a goal of enabling council to make a final decision by mid-summer. As in recent summers, we will have one service at 9:30 on Sundays from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Weekend.
- Pastor Chris reported that the Chin Baptist church would like to use a WHLC meeting room for Bible Study, parenting classes, and other faith formation activities on Saturday nights. The council approved the request. This usage will not affect WHLC's Saturday night services.
- Ticket sales for the WHLC 75th Anniversary Celebration Luncheon will begin on the May 4/5 weekend. Planning continues for holding Sunday events to recognize leaders, members, and other groups that have been a part of the 75 years of WHLC ministry.
